

**SELLWOOD PRINCIPAL RECONFIGURATION DISCUSSION 5-30**

The Cluster Principals came together to begin the dialog about educational aspects associated with the proposed list of changes your group addressed. This is a summary of the discussion. All of these options close one school in the Cleveland cluster.

<b>Option 1: Close Llewellyn and move current Llewellyn students to Sellwood to create a K-8;</b>		
<p align="center"><b>Educational Strengths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This cluster would have a K-8 configuration</li> <li>• Entire Llewellyn community would move together</li> <li>• Fewer SpEd programs would need to be moved</li> </ul>		<p align="center"><b>Educational Challengers</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Would force Lewis and Duniway to go K-8; difficult fit for both schools without boundary change.</li> </ul>
<p align="center"><b>Enrollment Impact</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sellwood would be very tight for one year before middle school population graduates out</li> <li>• Duniway could no longer take any transfers ~ 55 Ks per year</li> <li>• Difficult for Lewis to go K-8 in current boundaries – even moving 2 SPED classes out would result in some crowding once 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> is there</li> </ul>	<p align="center"><b>Boundary Impact</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Would need to send ~ 15 Lewis students per year to Grout or Woodstock to reduce crowding at Lewis</li> <li>• Sellwood- Duniway boundary adjusted to send 130 students from Duniway to Sellwood west of 99E/Mclaughlin</li> </ul>	<p align="center"><b>Facilities Issues</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Llewellyn and Sellwood are both rated 5 buildings</li> <li>• Adaptations required to Sellwood to accommodate primary grades</li> </ul>

**Option 2: Close Lewis and move current Lewis students to Duniway**

<b>Educational Strengths</b>		<b>Educational Challenges</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lewis is the smallest building in the cluster</li> <li>• Fewer schools impacted.</li> </ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Several SpEd classes would need to be moved</li> <li>• Duniway would be crowded in first few years</li> <li>• Lewis is the best facility in the cluster</li> </ul>	
<b>Enrollment impact</b>	<b>Boundary Impact</b>	<b>Facilities Issues</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If only Lewis neighborhood kids move to Duniway (25-30 per year) then it will fit – bit it would be tight for a few years</li> <li>• Duniway could no longer take transfers</li> <li>• Students currently transferring to Lewis from other neighborhoods would need to return to neighborhood school (mostly Woodstock, Woodmere and Whitman)</li> <li>• Lewis SPED classes could move to Grout?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Boundary change: Sellwood/Duniway boundary moved to 99E/Mclaughlin:</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lewis is rated 1</li> <li>• Duniway rated 4</li> </ul>	

**Option 3: Close Duniway and move students to Sellwood to form a K-8**

<b>Educational Strengths</b>		<b>Educational Challenges</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The cluster would have a K-8 configuration</li> </ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Duniway facility is a good one</li> <li>• Large transportation costs</li> </ul>	

<p><b>Enrollment Impact</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Would need to delay move until 08-09 in order to create enough space at Sellwood – only Duniway 6<sup>th</sup> graders would go to Sellwood in 2007-8</li> <li>• 2008-9 year would be very crowded at Sellwood</li> <li>• Duniway would have to limit transfers to keep a K class of 55-60</li> <li>• Lewis would be very tight as a K-8 – would need to move SPED classrooms to Grout</li> <li>• Llewellyn also a bit crowded</li> </ul>	<p><b>Boundary Impact</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Possible boundary change to move some Duniway and Llewellyn into Grout to relieve crowding</li> <li>• Significant transportation costs to send Duniway students to Sellwood K-8</li> </ul>	<p><b>Facilities Issues</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Duniway building condition rated 4, Sellwood rated 5</li> <li>• Some adaptations required to house primary grades at Sellwood</li> </ul>

**Option 1A Lewis and Duniway move to K-6 and feed Sellwood K-8 at seventh grade**

<p><b>Educational Strengths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Entire Llewellyn community would move together</li> <li>• Fewer SpEd programs would need to be moved</li> <li>• Potential to maintain greater choice of electives at 7-8.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Educational Challengers</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Retaining a part of “middle school” in a 7-8 (“junior” high) structure)</li> </ul>

<p><b>Enrollment Impact</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Duniway and Lewis fit fine</li> <li>• Sellwood overcrowded unless boundaries reduced so that it has only one class per grade up until 7<sup>th</sup> grade</li> </ul>	<p><b>Boundary Impact</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Could shift some Llewellyn to Grout to reduce Sellwood overcrowding</li> </ul>	<p>Facilities Issues</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Llewellyn and Sellwood both rated 5</li> </ul>
