What to do if the school you are interested in has no lottery slots

- A Return-to-Neighborhood Placement form is available for students who have transferred to another school but wish to return to their neighborhood school, even if there are no lottery slots. Return-to-neighborhood transfers are guaranteed, if the request is made by March 9. Download a Placement form at:

- Students who feel they have an extraordinary reason to attend a school closed for transfers should call the ETC at 503-916-3205 to obtain a petition request. There are no regular transfer slots at Cleveland, Franklin, Grant, Lincoln and Wilson High Schools, because these schools already have enrollment higher than 1350 students, the threshold set as part of High School System Design. Because of space limits, very few petition requests will be approved, but priority will be given to co-enrolled siblings. Petition requests made by March 9 will be answered by March 31. Random numbers will be assigned to petitions, and there is no priority for requests made earlier than March 9.
