



PPS Recycling



These materials should be bagged separately and put in "Recycling Only" dumpster

Paper

Recyclable

Mixed Paper: White paper, construction paper, sticky notes, envelopes, cereal boxes, etc.

Newspaper and Magazines: small amounts go in with paper, large amounts bagged separately

Cardboard: flattened and put in recycling dumpster. No bag needed.

Not Recyclable

Tissues, paper towels, carbon paper, paper cups, food soiled paper, frozen food boxes, milk cartons

Plastic Bottles and Aluminum Cans

Recyclable

Plastic Bottles: Clean, rinsed plastic containers with necks, remove caps

Aluminum Cans: Clean food and beverage containers, label can be left on.

Not Recyclable

Clamshell containers, large serving trays, plastic utensils, glass

These materials require special pick-up. **Do not** put in "Recycling Only" dumpster!

Batteries and CFL Light Bulbs
