Frequently Asked Questions –

Overview of Supplemental Educational Services

The term "supplemental educational services" refers to free extra academic help, such as tutoring or remedial help provided to students in subjects such as reading, language arts, and math.

Only income-eligible students who attend identified schools may participate in the program which is offered at no cost to families.

Transportation is not available and is the responsibility of the parents.

The tutoring must be provided by one of the Oregon state approved providers. Families can select one (1) provider and one (1) subject from the list included in this brochure.

Which schools offer SES to their eligible students?

Bridger School, George Middle School, Kelly Elementary School, Jefferson High School, Jefferson YWA, and ACT, POWER, and SEIS on Roosevelt Campus.

How do I sign my child up?

You will need to complete a selection form (attached) and return it to the office. The first enrollment period for SES will be from now — October 14, 2011.

How much tutoring can my child receive?

Portland Public Schools will pay up to \$1657 per student to a State approved provider. Providers charge different rates for their tutoring services; therefore the number of tutoring sessions will vary depending on the provider.

How will the tutoring provider be paid?

Portland Public Schools will enter into a contract with the provider that you select, and the provider will bill the district directly.

When will services begin and how long will services be provided?

Tutoring will begin in early October as part of each school's SUN CS program. The number of sessions available varies from provider to provider. Information on the number of sessions covered is included on the approved provider matrix.

How can I get more information?

Sample Questions to Ask When Selecting a Provider

- Does the provider/instructor have experience in working with students that are my child's age?
- Does the provider have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds?
- If needed, can the instructors speak languages other than English?
- How does the provider's curriculum align and support what is taught during the school day?
- How does the provider identify what my child needs?
- How many sessions will my child receive?
- What are the attendance requirements?
- How will progress be evaluated?
- How will I know how my child is performing?
