Advanced Placement coursework that is accessible to all students, college readiness training and engaging electives support a college-preparatory culture and nurture a love of learning. Instructional support services, funded by a \$3 million three-year federal grant, help all Madison students meet their academic potential. Ask about our new after-school and Saturday tutoring programs.

An expansive arts program engages student musicians, painters, actors and designers. The Step Up mentoring program, an on-site health clinic and SUN Community Schools support the whole student.

Madison students speak more than 30 languages, from Spanish and Somali to Thai and Turkish. At Madison, students learn to be world citizens.

The Madison campus, a gateway to the Roseway neighborhood, is flanked by Glenhaven Park and Rose City Golf Course.
