


## Quick Reference Guide

### “Connecting to a Wireless Network”

Use these directions for your mobile laptop lab.

<b>Step 1</b>	Power up the laptop and log on.	
<b>Step 2</b>	After the laptop has booted successfully, it should automatically search for a wireless signal in the local area.  If this does not happen, the wireless access point may be turned off.	
<b>Step 3</b>	Press wireless button with an antenna signal icon located above the keyboard.	
<b>Step 4</b>	An icon located in the lower right corner of the screen will become active. Look for the icon that has a yellow ball moving left to right.  If a wireless signal cannot be automatically found, double-click on the wireless icon in the lower right corner.	
<b>Step 5</b>	Click on 'View Wireless Networks' button.

<p><b>Step 6</b></p>	<p>A list of local wireless signals will be displayed.</p>	
<p><b>Step 7</b></p>	<p>Double-click on the signal to which you want to connect. A connection screen will appear.</p>	
<p><b>Step 8</b></p>	<p>Upon successful connection, the wireless signal you selected will be listed as connected.</p>
