

OSX Server Project

Hook Up the Server Shares on an OSX Computer

Staff Computer

1. Log in to teacher's account on OSX computer.
2. Under Go/Connect to server. Enter IP of server.
3. Log in using the teacher's username/password.
4. Mount the Home and Shared Staff (also Shared Office if applicable) volumes.
5. Make alias** of shares you need: User's home directory*, Shared Staff
6. To use these folders, the teacher will need to log in using their email username and password.

Student Computer

1. Log in to student's account on OSX computer.
2. Under Go/Connect to server. Enter IP of server.
3. Log in using the classroom's username/password.
4. Click options button and check on save password in Keychain.
5. Mount Home, and Shared Apps (if applicable for shared software).
6. Make alias** of individual classroom folder*, rename to "Classroom Folder"

Shared Computer

7. Log in to student's account on OSX computer.
8. Under Go/Connect to server. Enter IP of server.
9. Log in using any classroom's username/password.
10. Mount Home, and Shared Apps (if applicable for shared software).
11. Make alias** of folder containing classroom folders*, rename to "Classroom Folders."

*Home Folder locations: Home folders are filed using the first two letters of the user name.

- ❑ User lsmith would be located at home/l/s.
- ❑ Classroom arl10 would be filed under home/a/r. The R folder would contain all of the classroom folders for Arleta.

** To make an alias of a folder on the server, click on the folder, and holding apple and option, drag folder to desktop. Make sure you are not *copying* the folder – you will see an arrow as you are dragging and also on the icon on the desktop. To make an alias of a volume, such as Shared Staff, click on the icon and type apple-l.
