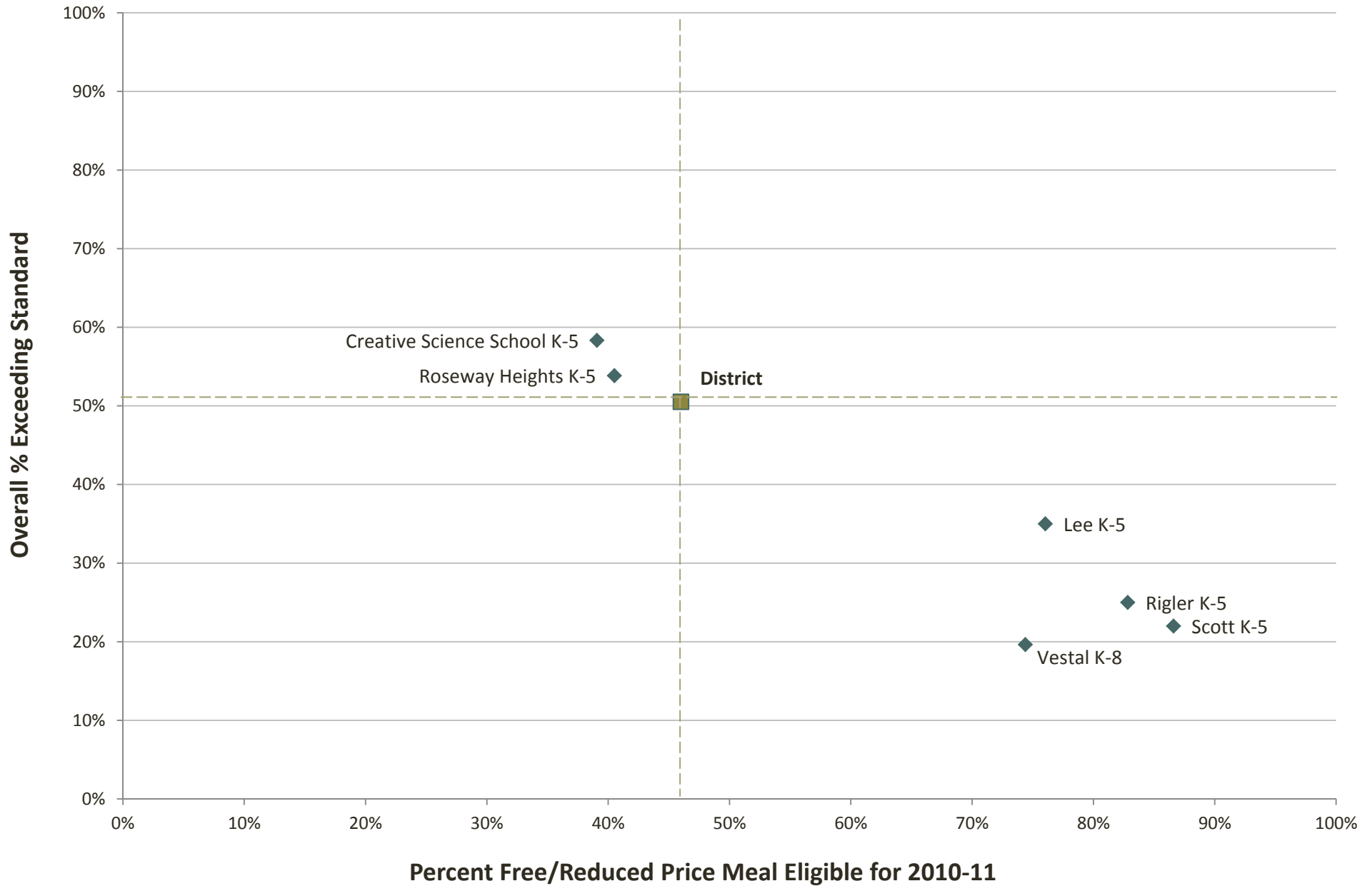

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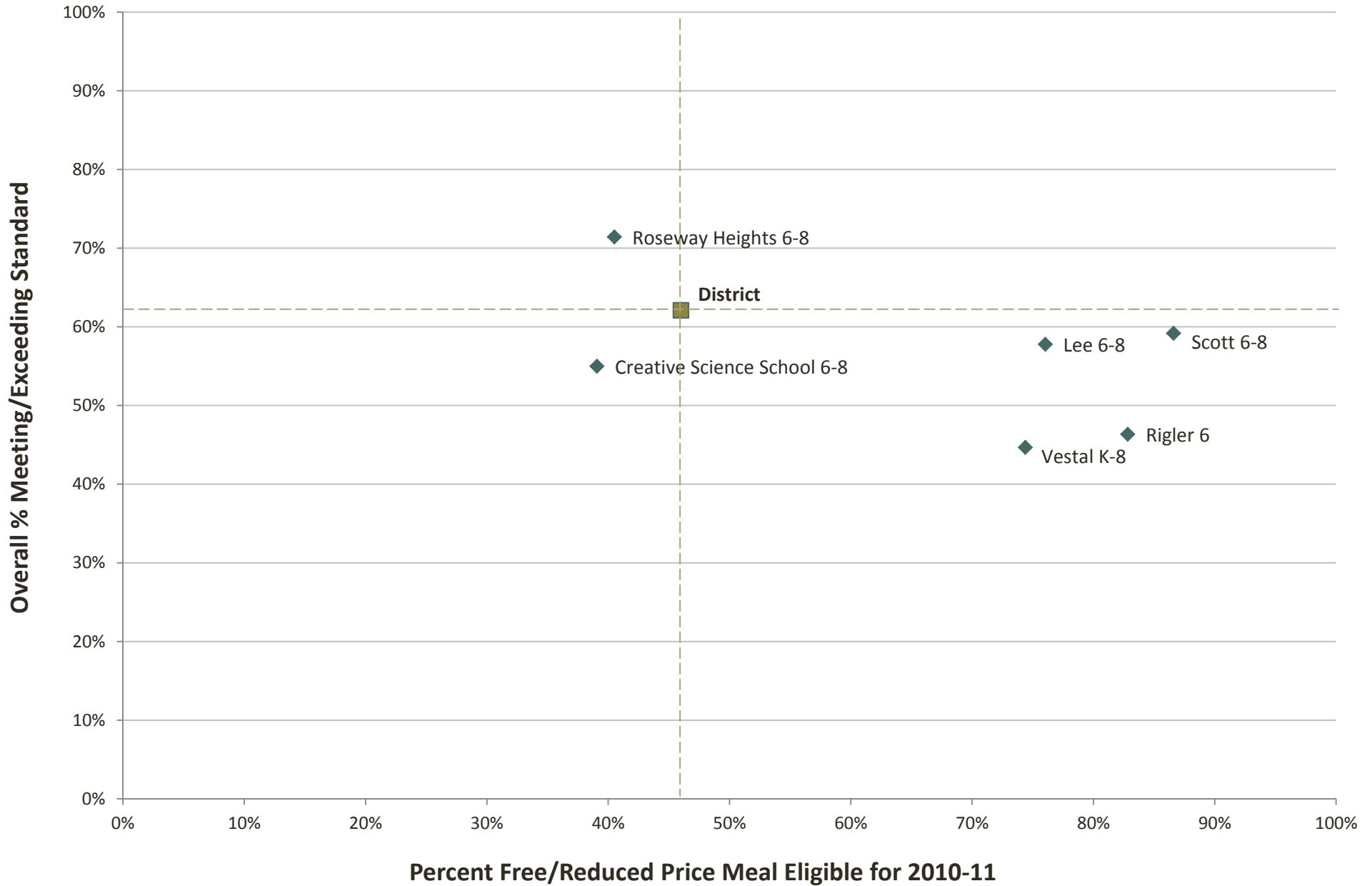
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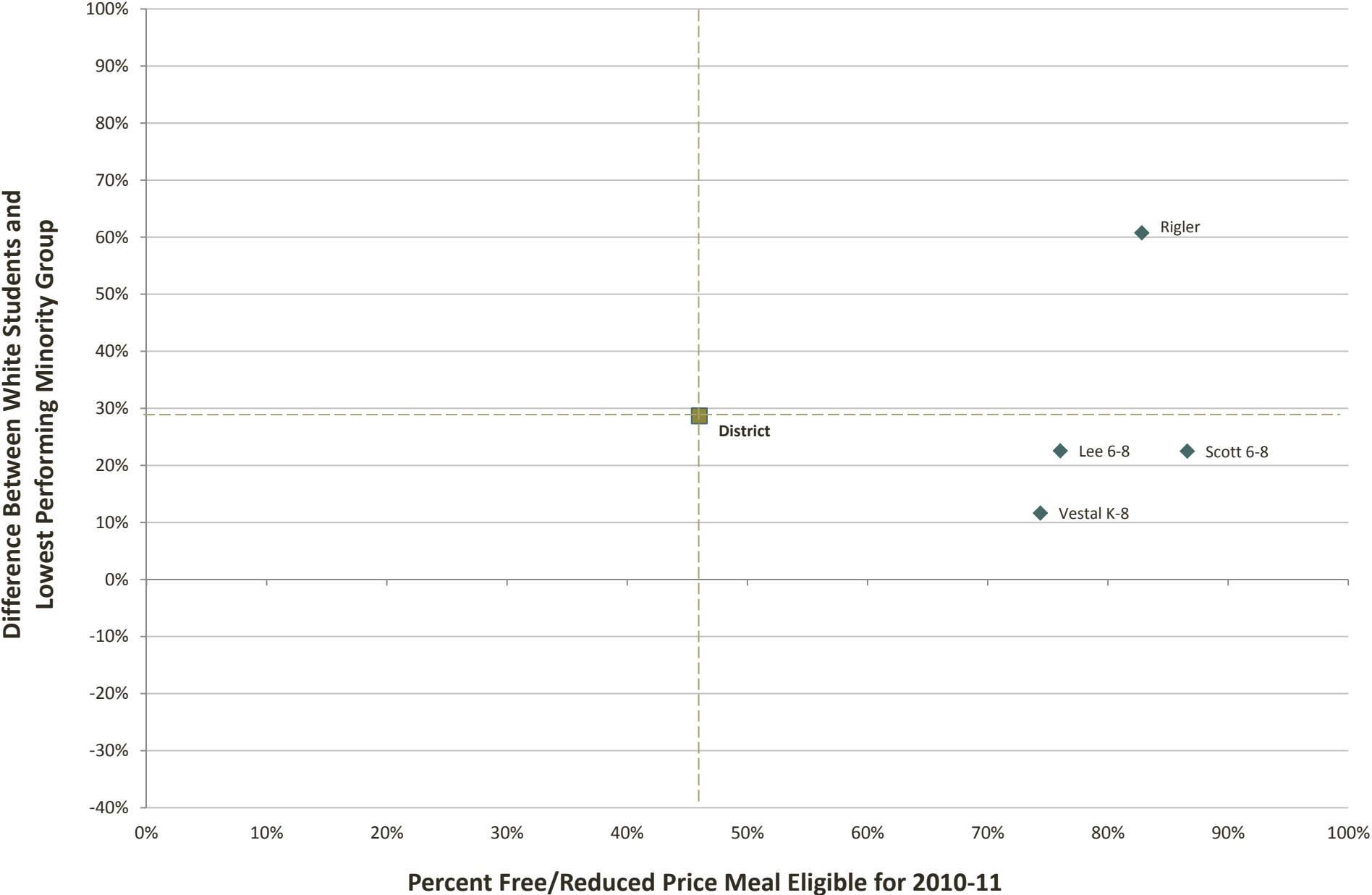
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Madison Cluster: 7th Grade Writing

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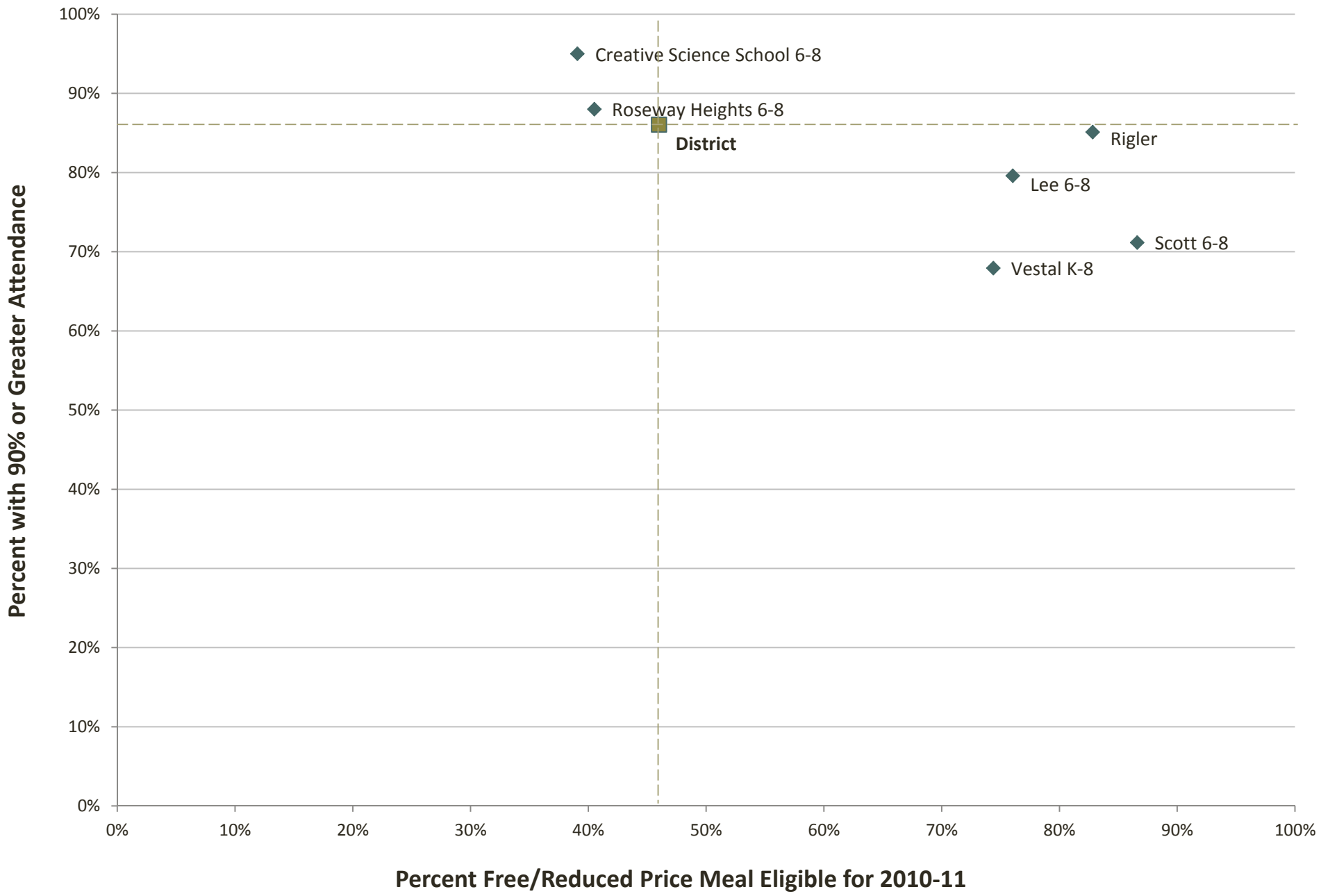
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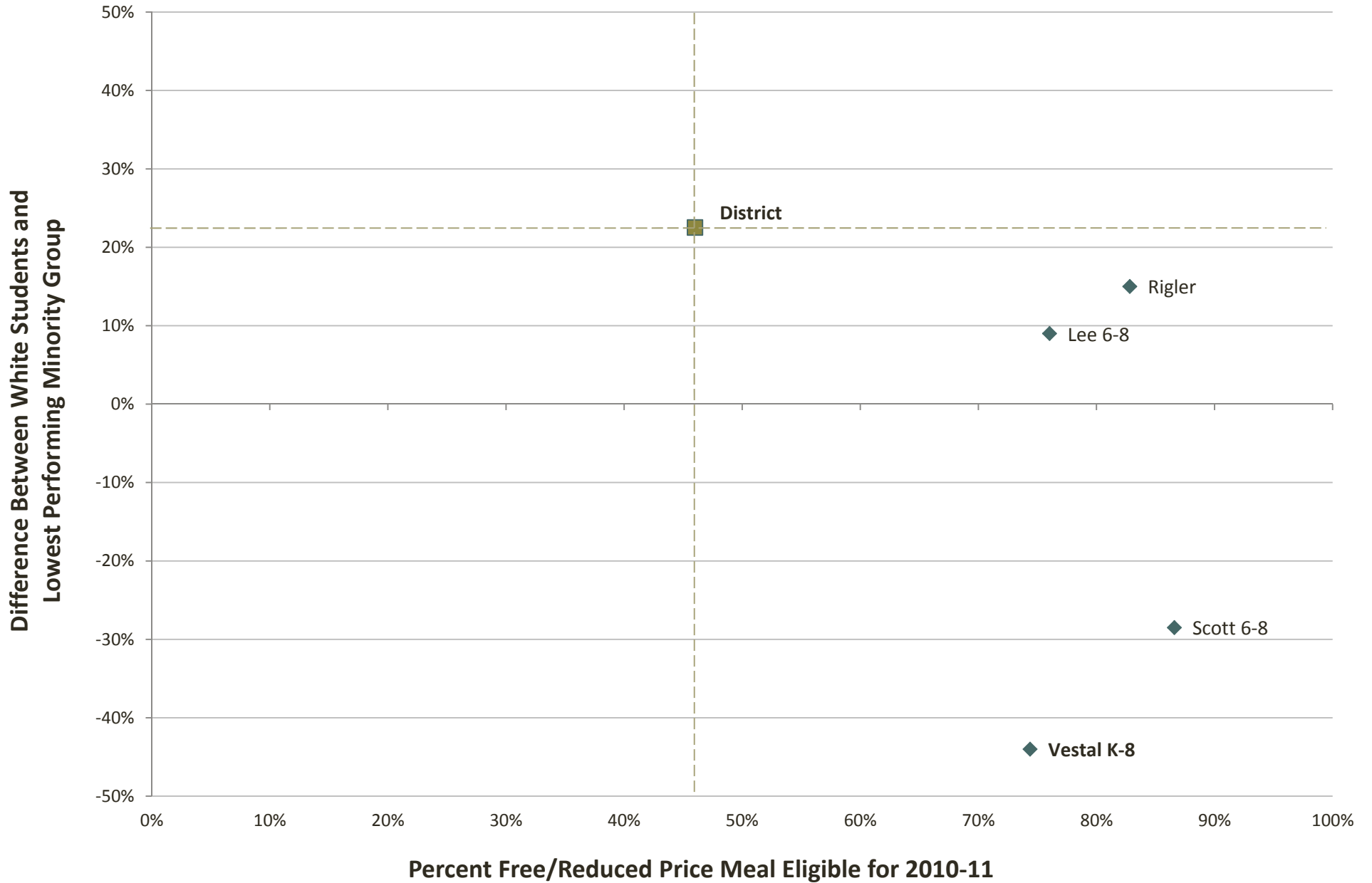
Madison Cluster: 7th Grade Attendance

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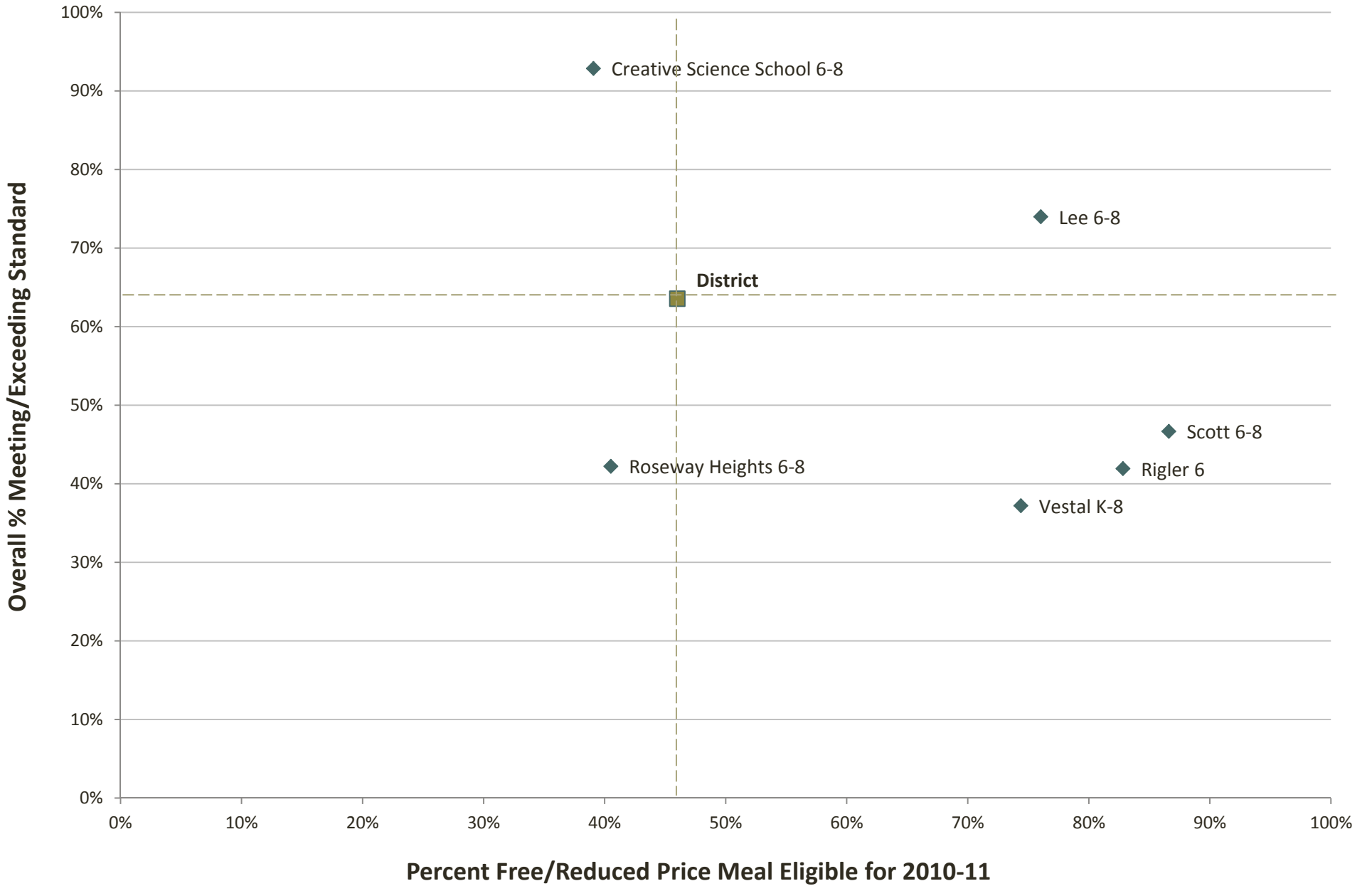
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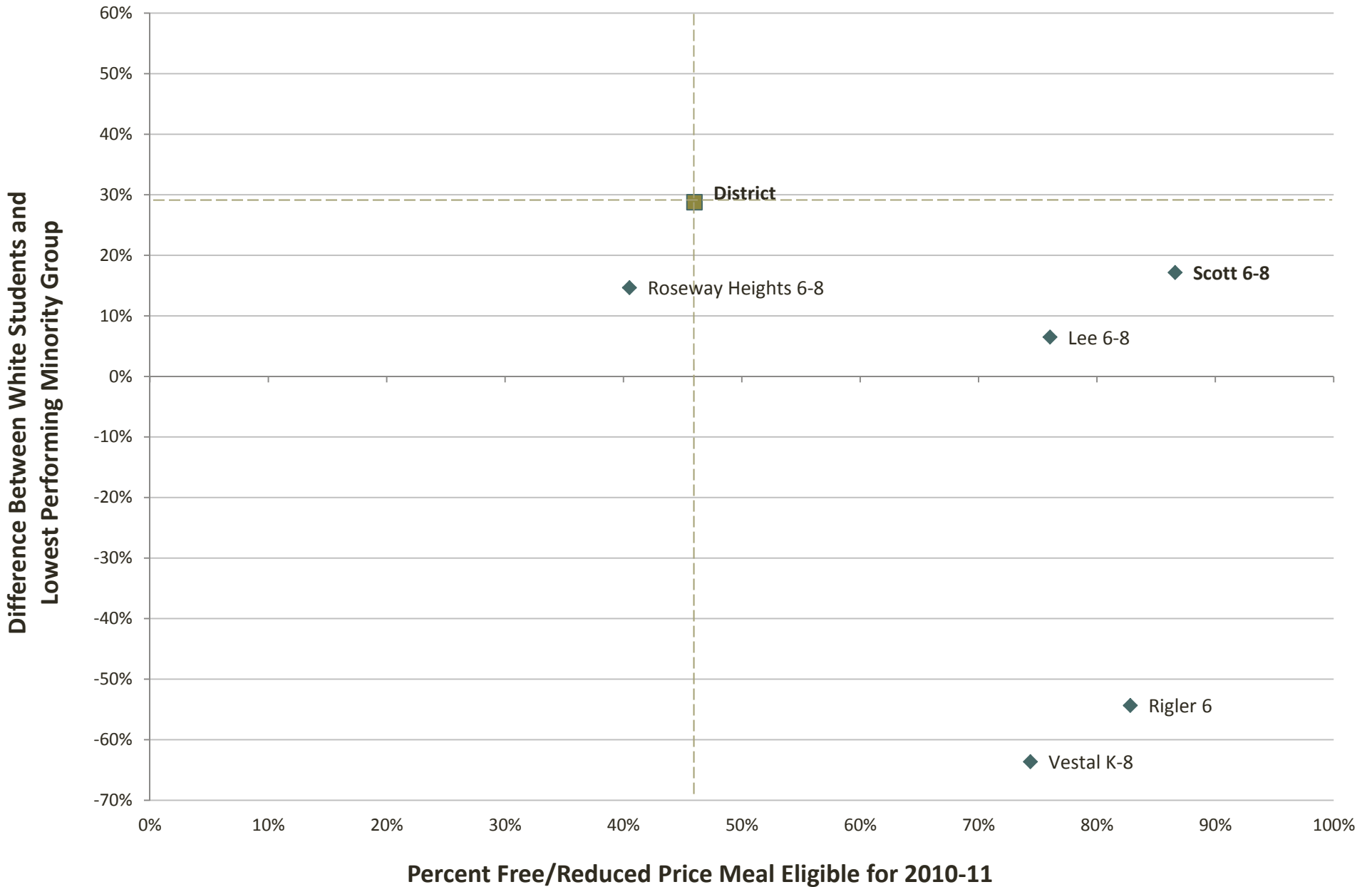


Madison Cluster: 8th Grade Algebra

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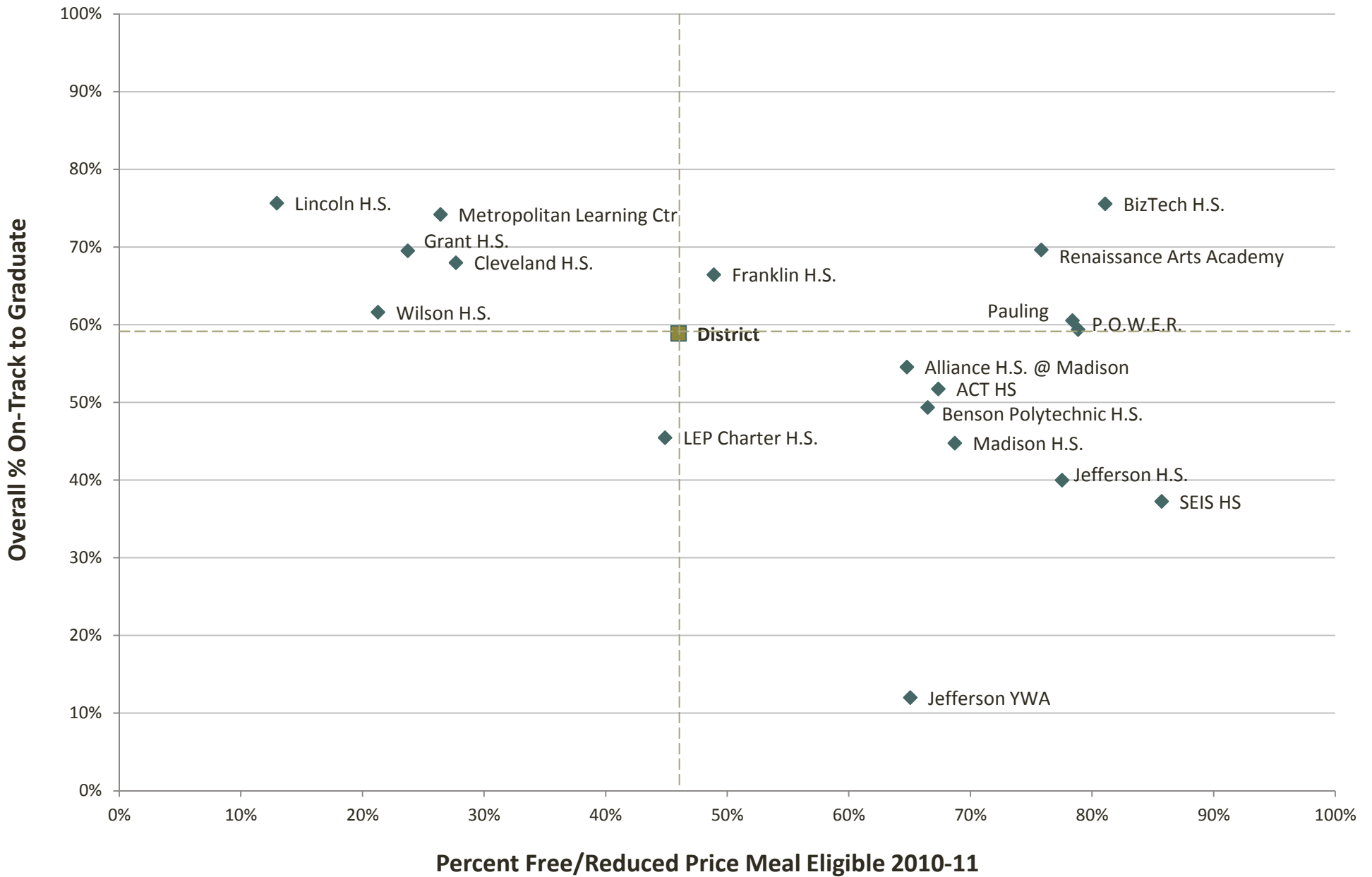
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10th Grade Milestone: On Track to Graduate
