## VISION

The vision of the **Multnomah County Health Department School-Based Health Center Program** is to facilitate access to comprehensive preventive, primary, and mental healthcare for Multnomah County school-age youth to keep them healthy and ready to learn.

## MISSION

In partnership with schools, families, healthcare providers and community agencies, Multnomah County School-Based Health Centers:

- Provide culturally sensitive and age-appropriate healthcare, education, outreach, and referrals to school-age youth;
- Facilitate early identification of high-risk behaviors and health issues that enable timely intervention and treatment;
- Reduce barriers to healthcare by being conveniently located in schools and by offering confidential care in a safe environment regardless of insurance coverage and ability to pay;
- Promote healthy lifestyle choices and empower youth to take responsibility for their health and healthcare;
- Encourage parent or guardian involvement to support and sustain successful health outcomes.

## SERVICES

- Routine physical exams, including sports physicals
- Early detection, diagnosis, and treatment of illness and injury
- Vision, dental, and blood pressure screenings
- Immunizations
- Mental health services
- Age-appropriate reproductive health
- Routine lab tests
- Prescription medications
- Health education, counseling, and wellness promotion
- Fitness and nutrition education and counseling
- Referrals for healthcare services not provided at the clinics
- Classroom presentations



## COST

While students are not charged for services or prescriptions received at their school-based health center, Medicaid and other third-party insurers are billed.

Families with no health insurance are referred to an Eligibility Specialist to see if they qualify for the Oregon Health Plan or other insurance programs.



## STAFF

The staff at the School-Based/Linked Health Centers include:

- A Senior Office Assistant
- a Nurse Practitioner
- a Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) or Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)
- a Community Health Nurse (RN)
- a Mental Health Consultant (most sites)
- Outreach Workers who work in the schools and the community to facilitate access to healthcare and provide health education
