

# Crisis or High-Risk Behavior Flow Chart

A student showing any *one* of the high-risk behaviors below requires immediate response:

- Serious physical fighting
- Severe destruction of property
- Severe rage for seemingly minor reasons
- Detailed threats of lethal violence
- Possession and/or use of firearms and other weapons
- Sexual aggressiveness (perpetrator or at risk for potential perpetration)
- Fire setting
- Serious self-injurious behaviors or threats of suicide
- Student admits to having a plan and/or method to hurt self or others

Staff informs administrator immediately

Administrator contacts student's parent/guardian

If needed, administrator calls Multnomah County Crisis Line (503.988.4888) for consultation or to request intervention

Note: Intervention from Project Respond or Crisis Prevention Outreach will require parent/guardian permission

Complete Mental Health Services Request form to document incident

Designee may also notify the following (as appropriate)

School Supervisor, Law enforcement,  
PPS Security Services, Special Ed, and/or ELL
