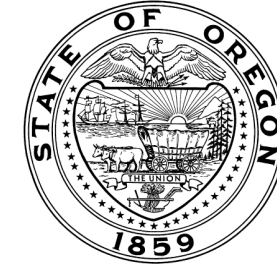

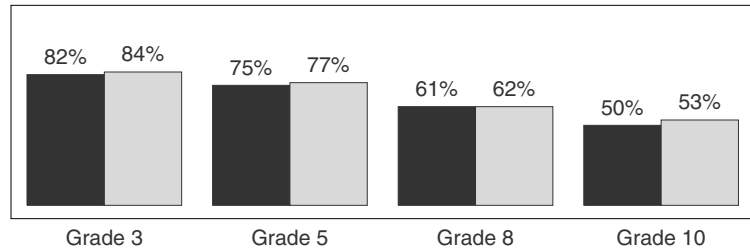

PERCENT OF STUDENTS MEETING STANDARDS

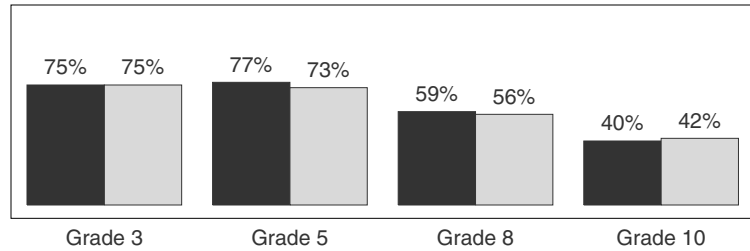
The graphs below show the percent of students who met the 2001 state standards in reading, mathematics multiple choice, writing, and mathematics problem solving.

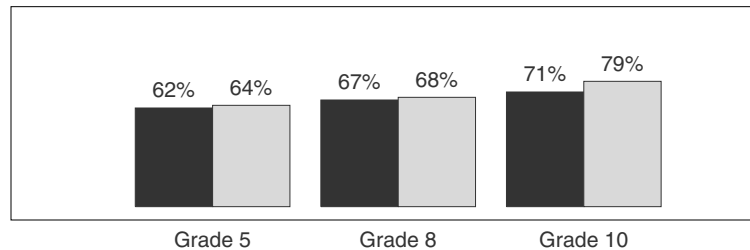

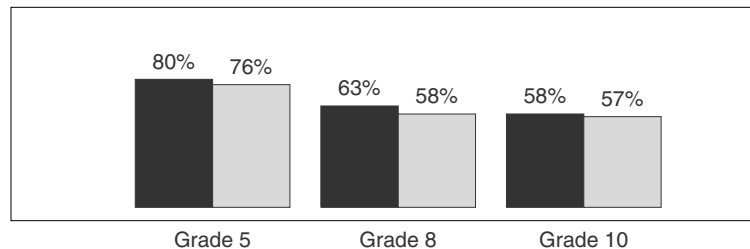
MATHEMATICS MULTIPLE CHOICE

MATHEMATICS PROBLEM SOLVING

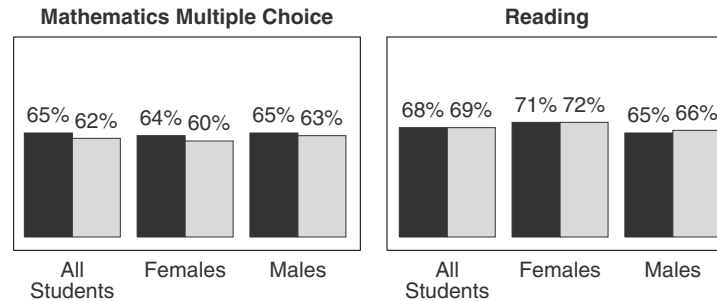

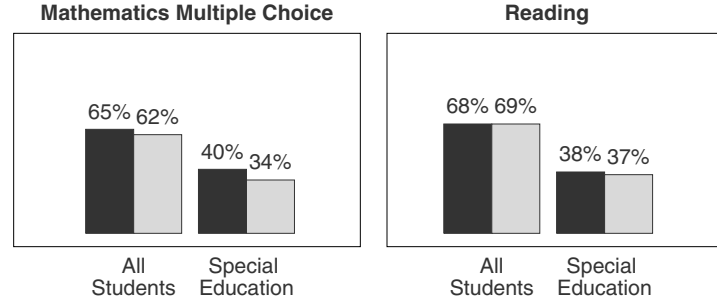

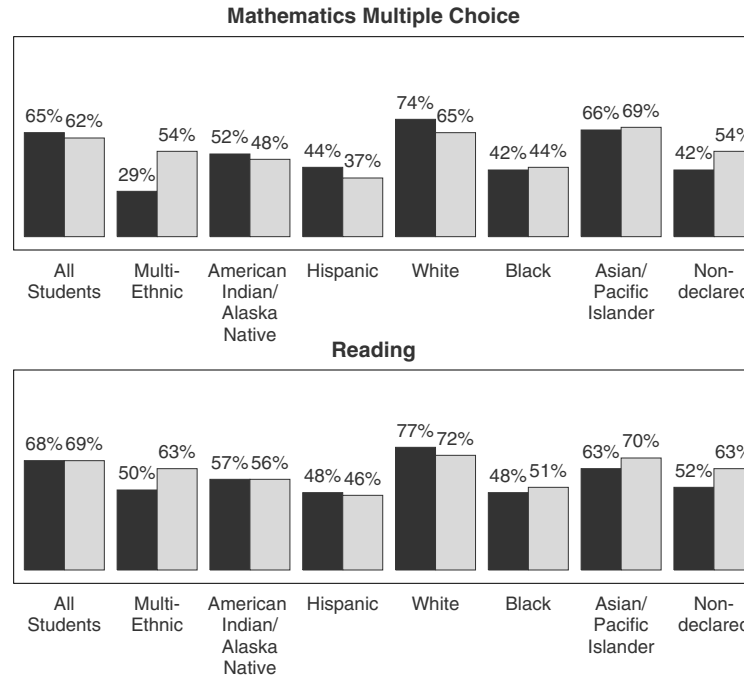
