7. COMMENTS/ISSUES

From 2013-14 to 2015-16, Chief Joseph and Ockley Green were merged into a dual campus K-8 school where Kindergarten to 3rd grades students attend the Chief Joseph site and 4th-8th grade students attend the Ockley Green Campus.
For 2016-17, Chief Joseph was a K-4 School; for 2017-18, Chief Joseph is a K-5 school.

Effective 2017-18, a boundary change assigns the Chief Joseph E.S. catchment area north of N Lombard St and west of I-5 to Peninsula E.S.

As of 2018-19, The Oregon Department of Education has identified this School as a Targeted Support and Improvement School for the following Students: Economically Disadvantaged, Students with disabilities, Black/African American.
