As of 2016-17, Ockley Green was a 5-8 school. For 2017-18, Ockley Green became a 6-8 Middle School.

Ockley Green is a Dual Assignment neighborhood where ninth-graders can attend either Jefferson Middle College or Roosevelt.

As of 2018-19, The Oregon Department of Education has identified this School as a Targeted Support and Improvement School for the following Students: Economically Disadvantaged, Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino.
