7. COMMENTS/ISSUES

Scott was previously designated as a Focus school.

Effective 2018-19, Rigler is an immersion only school, with the neighborhood students being reassigned to Scott.

Effective 2018-19, Roseway Heights reconfigured from a K-8 to a Middle School, with 6-8 students coming from Roseway Heights, Scott, Lee, and Vestal. Scott, Lee, and Vestal became K-5's. Rose City Park opened as a new elementary school, with K-5 students coming from Roseway Heights, including the Vietnamese Immersion Program. Two boundary changes were made which redirected some Rose City Park students to Lee and some Lee students to Rose City Park.

As of 2018-19, The Oregon Department of Education has identified this School as a Comprehensive Support and Improvement School.
