<p>6) ART: Dynamic frames/borders surround the section or fill the space ART: All artwork is lightly sketched; erasure marks do not clutter the work ART: Artwork is connected to the assignment ART: Art interpretations begin to have connections to each other; a theme is developing COLOR: Color is meticulously applied COLOR: Color greatly enhances the design. Multiple techniques or media are used COLOR: All writing can be easily read and may be enhanced with an outline DIRECTIONS: Assignment directions are followed and well developed beyond the minimum DIRECTIONS: Homework is complete SPELLING: Only rare spelling mistakes which do not impair readability SPELLING: Sight words spelled correctly HANDWRITING: Letter size and formation used creatively to support meaning ACCURACY: Answers correct with enhancements</p>	<p>5) ART: Interesting frames/borders surround the section or fill the space ART: All artwork is lightly sketched; erasure marks do not clutter the work ART: Artwork is connected to the assignment ART: Most artwork moves beyond a literal interpretation COLOR: Color is carefully applied COLOR: Color enhances the design and multiple media may be used (crayons, colored pencil, collage, flaps...) COLOR: All writing can be easily read DIRECTIONS: Assignment directions are followed and developed beyond the minimum DIRECTIONS: Homework is complete SPELLING: Most writing conventionally spelled SPELLING: Rare mistakes on sight words HANDWRITING: Letter size and formation clear and readable; experiments with creative use to support meaning ACCURACY: Answers correct</p>

Erasure marks do not clutter the work ART: Artwork is connected to the assignment ART: Some art connections move beyond literal COLOR: Color is carefully applied COLOR: Color supports design COLOR: All writing can be read DIRECTIONS: All elements of the assignment directions are followed DIRECTIONS: Homework is complete SPELLING: Transitional to conventional spelling SPELLING: Most high frequency words spelled correctly HANDWRITING: Letter size and formation readable ACCURACY: Answers mostly correct</p>	<p>3) ART: Some attempt to surround the section or fill the space using frames/borders ART: Sketches may be more darkly drawn; erasure marks are somewhat noticeable ART: Some attempt has been made to connect the artwork to the assignment ART: Artwork is based primarily on literal interpretations COLOR: Color is inconsistently applied COLOR: Color somewhat supports design COLOR: Most of the writing can be read although some may be obscured by the application of color DIRECTIONS: Some elements of the assignment directions are followed DIRECTIONS: Homework is mostly completed SPELLING: Some spelling errors that begin to impair meaning SPELLING: Some high frequency words spelled correctly HANDWRITING: Letter size and formation somewhat Readable ACCURACY: Answers somewhat correct</p>
<p>2) ART: Limited attempt to surround the section or fill the space using frames/borders ART: Sketches are made with bold lines; erasure marks, tears and/or folds in the paper that detract from the work ART: Artwork has few connections to the assignment ART: Art connections are based on the most literal elements of the assignment (on time=clock) COLOR: Color is haphazardly applied COLOR: Color is inconsistently applied and is contrary to the work in places (a single color used over an area) COLOR: Most assignment work may be obscured by the application of color DIRECTIONS: Few assignment directions are followed DIRECTIONS: Homework is only partially completed SPELLING: Spelling errors obscure the meaning SPELLING: Frequent mistakes with sight words HANDWRITING: Inconsistent letter size and formation significantly impair readability ACCURACY: Major errors in answers</p>	<p>1) ART: Minimal or no visible attempt to create frames/borders ART: Lines are drawn heavily and carelessly; erasure marks, tears and/or folds completely detract from the message ART: Artwork has minimal or no discernable connections to the assignment ART: Artwork is not connected to the assignment or is absent altogether COLOR: Color is absent COLOR: Color is applied in a way that detracts from the design COLOR: Erratic or overly bold color application obscures the work DIRECTIONS: Assignment directions are not followed DIRECTIONS: Homework is minimally complete SPELLING: Spelling errors completely obscure the meaning SPELLING: Most sight words misspelled HANDWRITING: Letter size and formations vary to such a degree as to make the work unreadable ACCURACY: Answers incorrect</p>
