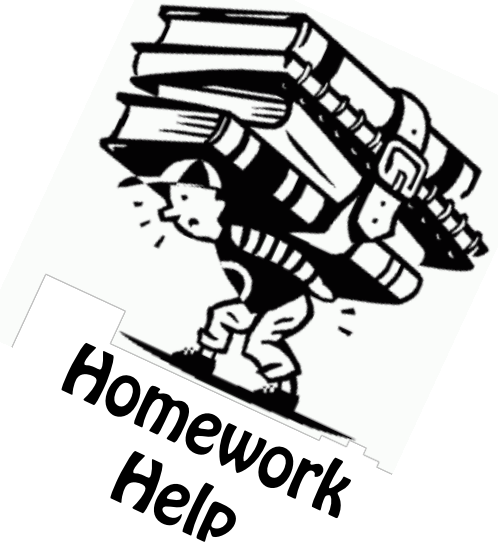


H² for 6/7/8

Beginning November 1st our 6th, 7th, 8th grade teachers will offer a 40 minute homework club on Tuesdays and Thursdays. H² is open to any 6/7/8 grade student and parent permission to attend is required. H² will run from 2:20 to 3:00pm in room 10, the Library's Living-room!



What is H²?

A homework club focused specifically for 6/7/8 grade students staffed by middle school teachers.

Two middle school teachers will staff H² and while they are there to help students, there will not always be a math teacher, a science teacher, or a social studies teacher present. Teachers may not be able to tutor in content specific instruction.

Who is H² for?

Any 6/7/8 grade student interested in having a quiet focused place after school to complete classwork.

H² is for students who need extra time or want extra help.

H² is for students whose parents have asked them to attend.

H² is for students whose teachers have asked them to attend.

What H² is not...

It is not a social club or snack time.

It is not a "detention" for misbehavior.

What H² is...

It is focused homework, study time.

It is a place for students to work, read, write, seek additional help with their studies.

While parents or teachers may ask a student to attend, disruptive, unfocused students will be asked to leave.

How do I communicate permission for my child to attend?

Email your child's classroom teacher at least one day before. There is no guarantee that email will be checked before 2:15 that day.

Write a note for your child to bring to H².

Students must make their own arrangements for transportation home!
