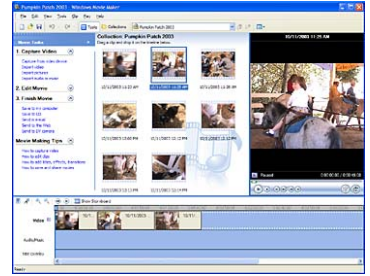

Content: (0-25 pts)

Narration is plentiful and clear. Volume is easy to hear, and is very informative. It matches the photos and the timing is appropriate
