

Dear Kindergarten Families,

Welcome to Beverly Cleary at Hollyrood. We are all very excited about the 2011-2012 school year. The kindergarten team is requesting a monetary donation of \$25. We will use this money to purchase the supplies needed for daily use by the students in class. This will allow us to have uniformity of supplies within each class, and take advantage of sales and school discounts. Do not send this money into the school during the summer.
