

Diorama

A diorama is a three-dimensional scale model used as a display.

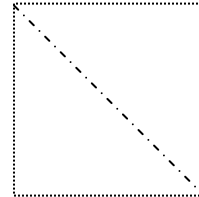
Shoebox Diorama:

1. Remove the lid.
2. Cut paper to fit the sides, back and bottom of the box.
3. Decorate the paper to match your project and glue the pieces to the insides of your shoe box.
4. Use miniature figurines to complete your project. These can be made from play dough or draw small pictures, cut them out and tape them to the inside of your box.

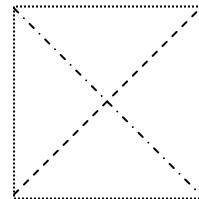
Note: You can substitute cereal or any other small box for your project.

Paper Triangular Diorama:

1. Fold a square piece of paper in half diagonally.



2. Make a second diagonal fold.



3. Cut from one corner to where the folded lines intersect. See red line in diagram.
4. Decorate the top half of the triangle.
5. Decorate one half of the lower triangles. Fold the decorated half over the top and staple or tape together. Add figurines to complete
