Instructions for registering for IB exams at Cleveland

Who needs to test? Any senior candidate for the IB Diploma or for IB Diploma Programme (DP) Courses credit in one or more subject areas. Candidates for the IB Diploma must take a total of six exams, with at least three being at the Higher Level (HL exams must be taken during senior year.). IB Diploma seniors should be registering for 4 to 6 exams. Many schools accept only HL scores for credit; however, all schools in the Oregon University System (OUS), as well as a number of other schools accept SL credit as well. For more information on university recognition, go to the IBO website at www.ibo.org.

Who should register? Any senior planning to complete IB assessments this year for the purposes of earning the IB Diploma or IB DP Course results.

What does it cost to take an IB exam? Your initial cost for one IB exam is \$260. Each exam after the first is another \$115. This includes a registration fee, a per subject fee, and a shipping fee. For this price, each internal assessment is moderated, and each external assessment is scored and moderated by an international examiner and a subject-specific senior examiner. The resulting score on a scale of 1-7 is awarded for the subject area. Typically, HL scores of 5, 6, or 7 will earn students credit equivalent to a year-length course, offering a substantial return on your investment.

Dates of Exams. The 2012 IB exam schedule is attached. Please remove and save it. Exams are scheduled for one-, two-, or three-day sessions. These dates are not negotiable or adjustable. Make sure that you have no conflicts before you register. The 2012 OSAA Spring State Competitions DO conflict with both AP and IB exams. If you are involved in a music or sports program scheduled to compete on an IB exam day, you should know that you will have to make a choice. See osaa.org for specific dates. District PIL competitions for state qualification are not yet scheduled and sometimes present conflicts as well. No refunds are made for IB exams not attended. There are also no re-take dates for IB exams.

How to register:

- 1) Fill out the registration form completely.
- 2) Read through the General Regulations, available on the Cleveland website at www.pps.k12.or.us/schools/cleveland/. Sign the acknowledgment indicating that you have read and understood these regulations.
- 3) Bring your registration form, signed acknowledgment, and a check made out to Cleveland High School for the proper amount to the Business Office at Cleveland no later than November 1, 2011. Early registration is appreciated. Free and reduced lunch recipients should check the appropriate line in the fee box and sign the ODE Reimbursement Plan Contract in lieu of payment.
- 4) Students will be asked to verify their registrations before November 10th.
- 5) Subject fees are refundable prior to January 27th, but the registration portion of the fee (\$145) is non-refundable.

Then what? Continue to work in your IB classes. Your teacher will prepare you for your exam sessions. They will share with you previous exam questions and give you all the information you need to be successful. You will also be working on IB Internal Assessments during the course. These IA scores will be used in combination with your exam score(s) to produce a final score on a 1 to 7 scale. Do your best work. College credit is most often awarded for scores of 5 or higher in HL classes. A full Diploma requires a minimum of 24 points; however, there are some exceptions. Please consult the General Regulations for more details regarding the Diploma award.

Where will the exams be held? Given the limited space available at Cleveland, most exams will be scheduled at an off-campus location. Further information regarding exact times and locations will be available from the IB Coordinator as we draw closer to the May exam session.

If you have questions regarding your IB exams, or need to apply for special testing accommodations, please see the IB Coordinator immediately. Registrations submitted after the deadline will incur additional fees. Students will be asked to verify their registrations prior to November 10th.
