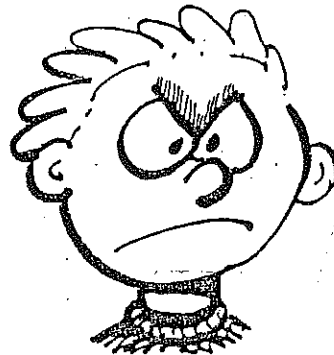


...HOW TO HAVE PROBLEMS IN EARTH SCIENCE:
