

Create a plot line to illustrate the development of the reading's plot.



- draw and label the appropriate parts for the assigned section of reading
 - exposition, rising action, climax, falling action/resolution
 - keep in mind that because your novel is broken into sections, your assigned section of reading may only have one part of a plot line
 - the plot line you draw may have mini-climaxes while continuing its rising action
 - chapters naturally have mini-climaxes and then a little falling action before rising in the next chapter
- include a brief description of what is happening at each part
 - draw a “call-out” line from the portion of the plot being summarized
 - list a brief, but understandable summary of the section
 - you can create symbols that clearly link your plot summary with your plot line
 - put a @ next to an identified portion of your summary and place the @ on your plot line where it occurs in the story
