Meroë    trade    iron    weapons and tools

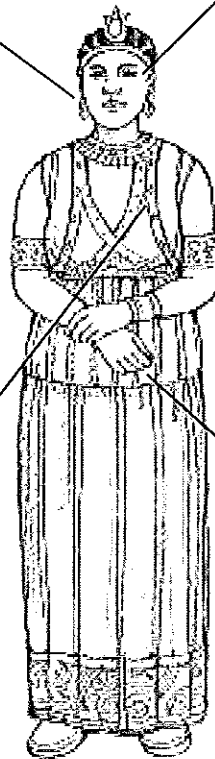
#### With my ears, I hear...

### 10.5 Kush Returns to Its African Roots

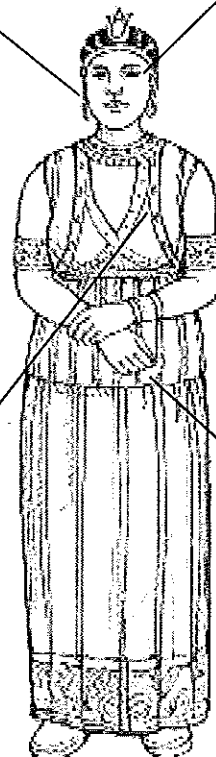
