- become an expert on a specific aspect of ancient Egypt
- develop research skills
- write an accurate and mistake-free paragraph using the writing process
- create a visually appealing and informative poster with your group
- prepare, practice, and deliver an oral presentation

Process:

1. placed in a group
2. given a theme
3. complete KWL
4. select a topic
5. research (text)
6. research (encyclopedia)
7. research (various sources)
8. organize notes
9. write rough draft of paragraph(s)
10. type rough draft
11. revise (emphasis - topic sentence and supporting details; conclusion)
12. edit (emphasis - capitalizing proper nouns; apostrophes)
13. publish paragraph(s)
14. collect items to decorate poster (every group member must contribute)
15. assemble poster
16. prepare presentation
17. practice presentation
18. deliver presentation

Things to include on your poster:

- title
- border
- paragraphs
- visuals that help viewers to better understand your topic
 - every group member must contribute
- bibliography on the back
- names of group members

- ### Poster Requirements
- Title: BIG – make it easy to identify the theme!
 - Border: Make sure it relates to your theme
 - Paragraphs: Give every paragraph a title identifying the topic
 - Pictures, illustrations, graphics, charts, etc.: Every group member should contribute visuals appropriate for their topic
 - Bibliography: Use the correct format; glue it on the back
 - Name of group members: On the front, inside the border
 - Neatness: Cut/paste/color carefully; type paragraphs

Requirements

For your Egypt Expert Poster Project presentation, you need to share what you learned about your topic in a fun and informative way. You must include the following:

- Introduction: Catchy & interesting—get our attention...
- Why you selected your topic
- The Basics: What everyone should know about your topic
- The Highlights: The coolest things you learned
- Conclusion: End in a way that keeps your audience thinking...

This is how you will be scored...

****Ideas & Content:** Did you do everything required? Was there enough information to make the presentation interesting?

****Organization:** Was the presentation organized and easy for the listener to follow and understand?

****Delivery:** Practiced, good eye contact, and appropriate speed, volume, and body language....

****Language:** Did you speak in a way that the audience could understand what you were talking about?

****Personal Best:** (you get to give this score) Do you honestly feel you did your best?

The presentation must be at least 90 seconds, but no longer than 3 minutes.
