BEFORE SCHOOL SUPERVISION

Students should not arrive at school prior to 8:45am as there is not always school supervision before 9:10am. Volunteers open the library for students before school at 8:05am beginning on September 19th. At 8:45am, students may go to the cafeteria to wait for school to begin. With prior arrangements with a teacher, students can go to a classroom before school. The teacher will provide them with a hall pass. There are no other supervised areas for students before the entrance bell rings at 9:10am. For safety, students cannot be unsupervised.

Box Tops for Education

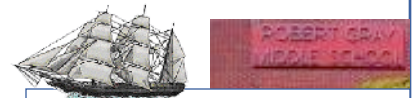
