NEW 6TH/7TH/8TH FAMILY ORIENTATION/ALL SCHOOL ICE CREAM SOCIAL

Students and families new to Hosford Middle School have an opportunity to meet administrators and tour the building.

OPEN HOUSE: The purpose of Open House is to provide parents and guardians with an opportunity to meet their student's classroom teachers for the 2011-2012 academic year and learn more about the curricular content of our academic program. Kevin Bacon, Hosford Principal, will hold 20 minute grade level meetings with parents between 7 and 8 pm in the cafeteria (times to be announced).

MIDTERM EVENING CONFERENCES (OCTOBER): This evening connects families of students receiving grades less than a C to their teachers and a plan of action for student success.

STUDENT/PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES: Opportunity for dialogue with teachers about your student's progress after the 1st quarter of school. The format is an open forum (meeting times not preset) and families meet only with teachers they choose.

WRITE NIGHT: Annual evening event created with the Hosford family in mind. Writing is a skill we strive to develop daily and we hope on this night everyone has an opportunity to create and share some of your writing with others. The gym will be set up with about 15-20 activity stations.

SCIENCE FAIR: Annual 6th grade science curriculum event. Students design science projects that demonstrate the inquiry model. At the fair students present their projects for review by adults.

STUDENT LED CONFERENCES: Conferences are drop-in only and held in the student's advisory classroom. Students share their academic year in a review for 10-15 minutes. A portfolio of school work will be presented along with test, attendance and other data. There is no school for students on this day.
