## HIP-HIP-HOORAY FOR KELLY'S BASKETBALL TEAMS

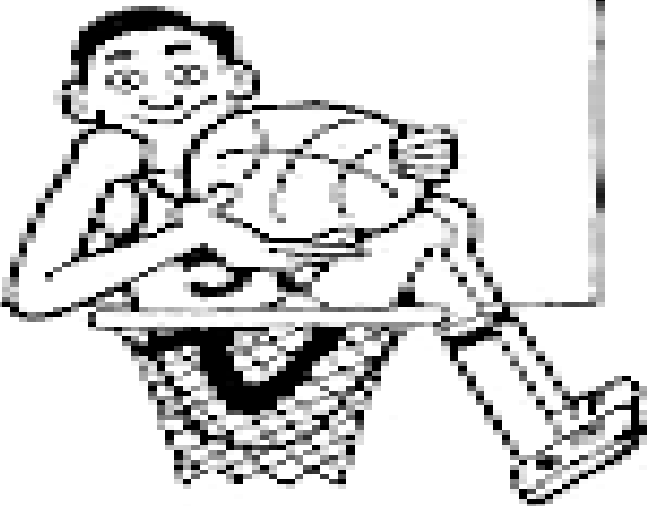
