The mission of Madison Music is to offer your students a well-rounded music education through performance and practice. The department purchases new music, repairs instruments, maintains and purchases outfits, travels to performances, hosts guest conductors, and improves the facility when possible. Over the last 6 years, we have received over \$15,000 in grants\* from donors to help build and maintain the music department. Registration fees, like grants, have helped to maintain Madison Music.
