



STUDENT PARKING AT WILSON HIGH SCHOOL

Parking at Wilson is limited. All students using the Wilson parking lot must register their automobile(s) in the main office and they must purchase a parking permit. Parking permits cost \$25.00 and are valid for one year. Students must pay all parking fines before they can purchase a parking permit.

A PARKING PERMIT DOES NOT GUARANTEE A PARKING SPACE. IT ALLOWS A STUDENT TO PARK IN THE LOT WHEN A LEGAL SPACE IS AVAILABLE.

Parking permits are not to be shared or transferred. If you engage in sharing or transferring parking permits, you will forfeit your permit. Students who drive sophomores and/or freshmen off campus may lose their parking permit or driving privileges.

The main parking lot is for juniors and seniors only. Sophomores may use the Mary Rieke parking lot or street parking. Sophomores will not be able to purchase parking permits. Student parking spaces are all the spaces on the outside perimeter of the parking lot unless otherwise designated. Students may also park in any space not marked staff/custodial/visitor.

Sophomores who drive to school and use the Rieke parking lot or neighborhood street parking are still required to register their cars. Students are not to enter the Rieke lot from Vermont Street. They will be issued a car registration tag that must be displayed on the rear view mirror. They will not be assessed a fee. The car registration helps the school identify cars that should not be in the area.

Wilson High School issues parking citations for all parking violations. These violations include parking in staff parking spaces, parking in no parking zones or in the fire lanes, or parking in spaces designated for the handicapped. These fines are payable to the bookkeeper.

A student will be issued a maximum of three citations. Any subsequent violation will result in a forfeiture of the parking permit and the car is subject to tow at the owner's expense. Driving underclassmen off campus during the school day will result in forfeit of the parking permit.

Any car parking in the Wilson parking lot without a valid parking permit is subject to being immobilized or towed at owner's expense.

NOTE: The Portland Police Department does patrol the lot and surrounding streets on occasion. They also will issue citations and/or tow cars that are illegally parked.

FYI: Speed limit in the parking lot is not to exceed 10 mph.
